**PAKISTAN (DEALINGS IN IMMOVABLE EVACUEE
PROPERTY) ORDINANCE, 1949**

(*Extention*)

No. F-28 (33)/49-P., 9th May 1950.—In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (4) of section 1 of the Pakistan (Dealings in Immovable Evacuee Property) Ordinance, 1949 (XI of 1949) the Central Government, in continuation of this Ministry's Notification No. F. 28 (33)/49-P., dated the 10th March, 1950, is pleased to direct that the said Ordinance shall remain in force in Baluchistan for a further period of one month beginning from the eleventh day of May, 1950.

IMPORTS AND EXPORTS (CONTROL) ACT, 1950

(*Prohibition of Imports*)

No. 335/260/1, 11th May 1950.—In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 3 of the Imports and Exports (Control, Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950) and in supersession of all previous notifications on the subject, the Central Government is pleased to prohibit the import by sea, land or air, from any country outside Pakistan of any goods of the description specified in the Schedule hereto annexed, except the following, namely:—

- (i) any goods imported by the Central Government for Defence purposes;
- (ii) any goods imported by the Central Government orders in respect of which are placed direct by the Department concerned;
- (iii) any goods in transshipment to a country outside Pakistan;
- (iv) any goods manifested for a country outside Pakistan which on import into Pakistan are bonded for re-export to that country;
- (v) any goods imported and bonded for re-export as ships' stores to a country outside Pakistan or any goods in transit through Pakistan by post, or any goods redirected by post to an address outside Pakistan without leaving the custody of the Postal Department;
- (vi) any goods imported for transmission across Pakistan by land to any country outside Pakistan, under claim for exemption from duty, or for refund of duty either in whole or in part, provided that such goods are imported by or on behalf of the Government of a country bordering on Pakistan or that the importer undertakes to produce within the specified period evidence that such goods have crossed the borders of Pakistan or in default to pay penalty equal to the value (c.i.f.) of such goods and provided further that nothing herein contained entitles any goods to an exemption from the Export Trade Control Regulations;
- (vii) any goods imported by an individual as passenger's baggage for the private and personal use of the passenger;
- (viii) *bona fide* samples or advertising matter supplied free of charge not exceeding Rs. 100 in c.i.f. value in one consignment;
