

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of section 2 of Regulation III of 1947.*—In section 2 of the Baluchistan Disturbed Areas (Special Powers of Armed Forces) Regulation, 1947, after the words "or air forces", the words "or civil armed forces, consisting of the Zohb Militia. Pishin Scouts, and Mekran and Chagai Levy Corps", shall be inserted.

The following Act of the Constituent Assembly passed on the 3rd day of January, 1949, is hereby published under the authority of the President of the Constituent Assembly for general information:—

AN ACT FURTHER TO AMEND THE INDIAN INDEPENDENCE ACT, 1947.

(10 and 11 Geo. 6, Ch. 30)

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Indian Independence Act, 1947, for the purposes hereinafter appearing:

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) This Act may be called the Indian Independence (Amendment) Act, 1949.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of subsection (3) of section 19 of the Indian Independence Act, 1947.*—After the proviso to subsection (3) of section 19 of the Indian Independence Act, 1947, the following further proviso shall be inserted:—

"Provided further that nothing in this subsection shall be construed as preventing any increase or reduction in the number of seats or any redistribution of seats in the Constituent Assembly for Pakistan, and the powers of the said Assembly shall extend to and be deemed always to have extended to the making of provision therefor."

[*Note.*—This amendment means that the Constituent Assembly for Pakistan can increase or reduce the number of seats or redistribute seats in the Assembly. The Constituent Assembly for Pakistan (Increase and Redistribution of Seats) Act 1949, was passed by the Assembly on 6th January, 1949.]

AN ACT FURTHER TO AMEND THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA ACT, 1935

(26 Geo. 5, Ch. 2)

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Government of India Act, 1935, for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) This Act may be called the Government of India (Amendment) Act, 1949.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

A REGULATION TO AMEND THE BALUCHISTAN ECONOMIC REHABILITATION REGULATION, 1948 (II OF 1948)

No. F. 5/81/41.—In pursuance of the provisions of subsection (3) of section 95 of the Government of India Act, 1935, as applied to Pakistan, the Governor-General is pleased to promulgate the following Regulation which has been made by him in exercise of the powers conferred by the said subsection:—

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Baluchistan Economic Rehabilitation Regulation, 1948 (II of 1948);

It is hereby enacted as follows:

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) This Regulation may be called the Baluchistan Economic Rehabilitation (Amendment) Regulation, 1948.
(2) It shall come into force at once.
2. *Amendment of section 2 of Regulation II of 1948.*—In section 2 of the Baluchistan Economic Rehabilitation Regulation, 1948, before the words "Assistant Rehabilitation Commissioners" the words "Deputy Rehabilitation Commissioners and" shall be inserted.

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) This Regulation may be called the Baluchistan Disturbed Areas Special Power of Armed Forces (Amendment) Regulation, 1948.
