ORDINANCE NA XXI OF 1946

An Ordinance to amend the Foreigners Act, 1940

(Published in the Gazette of India Extraordinary, dated the 25th September, 1946.)

WHEREAS an emergency has arisen which makes it necessary to amend the Foreigners Act, 1940 (II of 1940), for the purpose hereafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Indian Legislature is not in session;

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 72 of of the Government of India Act, as set out in the Ninth Schedule to the Government of India Act, 1955 (26 Geo. 5, c. 2), the Governor General is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Ordinance may be called the Foreigners Act (Amendment) Ordinance 1946.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of section 1, Act II of 1940.—In sub-section (3) of section 1 of the Foreigners Act, 1940 (II of 1940), for the words "during the continuance of the present war and for a period of six months thereafter" the words and figures "until the 25th day of March, 1947" shall be substituted.
