THE NATURALIZATION ACT, 1926

*ACT No. VII of 1926

[26th February, 1926]

An Act to consolidate and amend the law relating to the naturalization in [Pakistan] of aliens resident therein

WHEREAS it is expedient to consolidate and amend the law relating to the naturalization in ²[Pakistan] of aliens resident therein;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

- Short title, extent and commencement.- (1) This Act may be called the 1. ³[] Naturalization Act, 1926.
 - 4[(2) It extends to the whole of Pakistan.]

Effect of grant of certificate and taking of oath.- (1) No certificate of naturalization shall have effect until the person to whom it is granted has taken and subscribed the oath prescribed by section 6, but upon the taking and subscribing of such oath such person, and any child of any such person who has been included in the certificate under sub-section (2) of section 5, shall be deemed to be citizens of Pakista and be entitled to all the rights, privileges and capacities of a citizen of Pakistan bom within Pakistan, except such rights, privileges or capacities, if any, as may have been withheld from them respectively by the certificate, and shall within Pakistan be subject to all the obligations, duties and liabilities of a citizen of Pakistan; and the wife of any such person to whom a certificate of naturalization is granted after the commencement of the Indian Naturalization (Amendment) Act, 1935 (I of 1935), shall, if not already a citizen
