## ORDINANCE No. XVI of 1942.

An Ordinance to apply the Registration of Foreigners Act, 1939, to certain persons to whom that Act does not at present apply.

(Published in the Gazette of India Extraordinary, dated the 21st April, 1942.)

HEREAS an emergency has arison which makes it V necessary to apply the Registration of Foreigners Act, 1939, to certain persons to whom that Act does not at present apply;

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 72 of the Government of India Act as set out in the Ninth Schedule to the Government of India Act, 100, 6, c. 2, 1935, the Governor General is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (I) This Ordinance may be called the Registration Short title, extent and commence. Roreigners Act (Extending) Ordinance, 1942. of Foreigners Act (Extending) Ordinance, 1942.

- (2) It extends to the whole of British India.
- (3) It shall come into force at once,

2. The provisions of the Registration of Foreigners Application of Act, 1939, and of the rules and orders made therounder 1939 to cortain shall apply to and in relation to any person who was at persons. birth a subject of any State in Europe excluding His Majesty's dominions in Europe, or a Japanese, Chinese or Thai subject, as they apply to and in relation to foreigners as defined for the purposes of that Act.
